NATIONAL

1. Presidential Polls

Why in news - The Election Commission has announced the date for the Presidential election.

Key Points –

- Election date July 18, 2022. Counting of votes July 21.
- President Ram Nath Kovind's term ends on July 24.
- The electoral college will comprise 4,809 members 233 RS MPs, 543 LS MPs, 4,033 MLAs of states and the UTs of Delhi and Puducherry.
- The total value of votes will be 10,86,431 (5,43,200 for MPs or 700 votes each and 5,43,231 for MLAs based on the 1971 Census.).
- Highest value of an MLA vote Uttar Pradesh (208), Lowest Sikkim (7).
- The MLAs of J&K are no longer part of the electoral college.

2. 4G mobile connectivity in Pangong Lake

Why in news - Reliance Jio became the first network to provide 4G mobile connectivity in and around the Pangong area.

Key Points –

• Jamyang Tsering Namgyal (MP from Ladakh) inaugurated Jio Mobile tower at Spangmik village near Pangong lake.

3. SMBSaathi Utsav

Why in news - WhatsApp India launched SMBSaathi Utsav to support small businesses adopting digital mediums such as the WhatsApp Business app to run their business.

Key Points –

- Pilot launch Jaipur's Johri Bazaar and Bapu Bazaar.
- India is home to approximately 6.3 cr MSMEs accounting for 30% of the country's GDP and employing over 110 million people.

INTERNATIONAL

1. Thailand makes marijuana legal

Why in news - Thailand becomes the 1st Asian country to legalize marijuana (cannabis).

Key Points -

• For plantation, trading and medical use, smoking in public still remains a crime.

2. Indian patrol boats to Vietnam

Why in news - India handed over the 12 high-speed guard boats) to Vietnam on June 9, 2022.

Key Points-

- By Defence Minister Rajnath Singh at the Hong Ha Shipyard, Vietnam.
- The deal was executed by Larsen & Tourbo.

3. Aegean islands demilitarisation

Why in news - Turkish President Recep Tayyip Erdogan warned Greece to demilitarise islands in the Aegean Sea.

Key Points –

• Greece and Turkey are NATO allies.

About Aegean Sea

- The Aegean Sea is between the Greek and Anatolian Peninsulas in the Mediterranean Sea.
- It connects to the Black Sea and the Marmara Sea by the Bosphorus and Dardanelles strait.

- It is also called White Sea.
- Islands Kasos, Crete, Rhodes, Kythera, Karpathos, Gockeada and Bozkaada.

RANKS & INDICES

1. QS World University Rankings 2023

Why in news - The 19th edition of QS World University Rankings 2023 was released on June 08, 2022.

Key Points –

- Top 3 Massachusetts Institute of Technology (USA) (1st), University of Cambridge (UK) (2nd) and Stanford University(USA) (3rd).
- Top 3 countries with most institutions USA (201), UK(90) and China (71).
- 6 parameters are Academic reputation (AR), Employer reputation (ER), Faculty-student ratio (FSR), Citations per faculty (CpF), International faculty ratio and international students ratio.
- A total of 41 Indian universities have featured in the ranking.

2. CRE8 crypto index

Why in news - Coin Switch has launched the Crypto Rupee Index (CRE8).

Key Points-

- It is India's first benchmark index to measure the performance of the Indian Rupee-based crypto market.
- It includes the top eight crypto-assets -Bitcoin, Ethereum, Binance Coin, Ripple, Cardano, Solana, Polkadot and Dogecoin.
- It represents over 85% of the total market capitalization of cryptos traded in the Indian rupee.

APPS & PORTALS

1. CiSS Application

Why in news - The National Commission for the Protection of Child Rights (NCPCR) has launched the 'CiSS application' to rehabilitate street children.

Key Points-

- It was launched under the Baal Swaraj portal.
- NCPCR) is a statutory body established under the Commission for Protection of Child Rights (CPCR) Act, 2005.
- Under the act, a child is defined as a person in the 0 to 18 years age group.

1. Kheer Bhavani Mela

Why in news - Kashmiri Hindus celebrated the Kheer Bhawani Mela at Tulmulla in central Kashmir's Ganderbal on June 8.

Kev Points-

• It is dedicated to the Goddess Ragnya Devi.

Why in news - Assam celebrated Baikho festival for good rain and harvest.

Key Points –

• It is celebrated by Rabha tribes.

1. 'Ironman Triathlon'

Why in news - Shreyas G Hosur (1stIndian Railways officer) completed world's toughest triathlon on June 5, 2022.

Key Points-

- Venue Hamburg, Germany.
- He completed the championship in 13 hours 23 mins 36 seconds.
- The event included swimming for 3.8 km, cycling for 180 km and a run of 42.2 km.
- He is Deputy Financial Advisor of South Western Railway.

BIHAR

1. Khelo India Youth National Games

Why in news - Bihar got its first gold medal in Khelo India Youth National Games.

Key Points –

- Bhola Kumar (weightlifting) of Jehanabad has won the first gold medal for Bihar.
- He won in the snatch round with 127 snatches and 155 clean jerks.

2. Land record digitisation

Why in news – The deadline for land record digitization in the state extended by 4 years.

Key Points –

- Now, It would run till 2027.
- Budget for next 4 years 97 crores.
- 28 types records to be digitised.

• Digital India Land Records Modernization Programme (DILRMP) was started in Bihar in 2012.

3. Bal Hriday Yojana

Why in news – 384 children have got a new life due to the scheme.

Key Points-

- Top beneficiaries Patna (42), Vaishali (25) and Nalanda (24).
- Not a single child of Supaul and Purnia needed operation.
- It was launched in February 2021 for the treatment of children suffering from the problem of hole in the heart.
- Operation is done at Sri Sathya Sai Heart Hospital, Ahmedabad in association with Prashanti Medical Services and Research Foundation.

4. Raj Bhavan's new website

Why in news - Governor Fagu Chauhan launched the new website of Raj Bhavan on June 9, 2022.

5. Lalu Pathshala

Why in news – Former minister Tej Pratap Yadav aims to open 'Lalu Pathshala' on the birthday of RJD chief Lalu Prasad Yadav on June 11

1. Kurkihar (Gaya)
